CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

VACCINATIONS

All Vaccinations must be up to date and sighted by Committee when joining up or renewing, and when adding new dogs to your membership.

NOTICE OF GENERAL MEETINGS

Meetings usually held every two months, at the clubhouse after training on Sundays. Notification will be sent by email and will be put up on Website and Facebook. All are welcome

NAME TAGS

These are issued when joining up. Please be aware that you must display name tag when training.

RED RIBBON

red ribbon denotes a new member and new dog. The ribbon will remain on the dog through training until graduation to Class 1.

YELLOW BANDANAS.

Used for dogs that need their 'personal space'. Please ask owner using Yellow Bandana if you can talk to their dog.

CANTEEN

Free Coffee and Tea available before and after training sessions. Water \$1.00 and soft drinks \$2.00.

COMMITTEE

The Committee consists of President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Ordinary Member 1 & 2 and Chief Instructor. Elected at AGM.

This is to ensure the safety of members, their dogs, the instructors and visitors to the grounds.

YOUR ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE BEHAVIOUR OF YOUR DOG

Dog to Dog aggression.

Through lack of consciousness and control by the handler.

First Offence	Warning
Second Offence	Suspended from training for one month
Third Offence	Banned from training

Dog to person aggression

This has two sections and an incident will be thoroughly investigated.

Unprovoked

At any time on the training grounds or around the peripherals of the grounds. PENALTY- immediately banned from training

Provoked

If a person has provoked the incident by entering an area where a dog has been restrained.

PENALTY - The person will be issued with a warning. Two warnings and they will be banned from training.

Person to Person aggression Will not be tolerated by the Club.

If you have any concerns in relation to dogs or owners, or just want to clarify/discuss Code of Behaviour please see President, Vice President, Chief Instructor, Secretary, Treasurer, Committee members and Instructors.

CLUB RULES

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12. Caution must be taken around dogs wearing the 'Personal Space' Yellow Bandana.

13. Dogs deemed by the Chief Instructor to require muzzling, shall remain muzzled until the Committee deems otherwise.

14. Handlers to take all care necessary in avoiding confrontations between dogs.

15. Handlers are responsible for the actions of their dogs at all times when on and off the grounds. The Club and the Instructors maintain a high standard when training. All handlers are taught in Induction and Beginners on how to handle situations.

16. Minimum age for dog handlers is 12 years old, unless authorised by the Chief Instructor.

17. Parents/Caregivers of handlers under 15 years of age must remain on or near the grounds when the child is in class. Classified as Junior Members.

18. The Chief Instructor must assess children under (17 years of age) before being allowed to train in class. Classified as Junior Members.

19. Children accompanying parents/caregivers to the grounds on training days must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.

1. All dogs must be on lead whilst on the training grounds in class, and outside the training areas, unless otherwise instructed by the Instructor.
2. Off lead designated areas. If you are new and not sure of how your dog will go off lead, please keep lead on and talk to Instructors who are on the grounds
3. No dogs allowed on the equipment without permission of an Instructor.
4. Progression to next class is dependent on the Instructor in your current class.
5. Vaccinations for your dog must be up to date and presented upon signing up and or renewal.
6. No bitches in season are allowed on the training grounds.
7. No children are allowed to play on the agility equipment.
8. Owners are responsible for cleaning up their dog fouls on and off training grounds. Bins provided and doggie bags.
9. All litter must be cleaned up and placed in bins provided.
10. Appropriate enclosed footwear to be worn by handlers and family members at all times.
11. Caution must be taken when approaching pegged or un supervised dogs. Only Instructors or persons requested by the owners an approach these dogs.

CLUB RULES

MEMBERSHIP AND TRAINING FEES.

Membership is from 1st July to 30th June each year. Half Yearly from 1st February to 30th June. In addition, Training Fees are charged for each dog you are bringing to training sessions. Once you have finished Induction you just see the Committee members at Clubhouse who will have your name and dog registered and you will be marked off and given a stamp that indicates you have paid training fee/membership fees are on the Website (links and resources) under Information for New Members and on the Membership form.



20. Members shall always behave courteously to other members and officials of the Club.

21 Club Officials shall at all times behave courteously to all members of the Club.

22. Any disputes should be referred to the Chief Instructor at the time of the dispute.

23. Any dog to dog aggression, if unseen by Instructors, Chief Instructor or Committee members, must be reported immediately to the afore mentioned, and will be registered as an 'Incident'. The Club will endeavour to the best of its ability to follow through claims.

24. Membership is with Financial year.e.g. 1st July to 30th June. Members must be financial members in order to vote at the AGM.

25. Any person wishing to represent the Club or enter events/trials **under** the Club's name must be a current financial member, and see permission from the Committee.

26. Anyone wishing to use Club equipment must be a current financial member and log equipment out in the Equipment book.
